Timmerman originally trained as a research biochemist. As a biochemical analyst, she published many important papers, journal articles and book chapters. Later, she took a degree in naturopathy, specializing in homeopathy. She has studied intensively with George Vithoukas and Vasilis Ghegas.

Alize has been in practice since 1980. She began teaching homeopathy in 1986, establishing The Hahnemann Instituut of the Netherlands in the Hague, in 1988. In addition to a full schedule of seminars throughout the world, she teaches a bi-annual weeklong seminar for post graduate students of many nationalities at the Hahnemann Instituut.
